

KEY ACHIEVEMENTS

of the High Qualification Commission of Judges of Ukraine in February 2026



The High Qualification Commission of Judges of Ukraine and the Public Council of International Experts have commenced special joint sessions with candidates for the positions of judges of the High Anti-Corruption Court and its Appeals Chamber. A total of nine meetings were held, during which interviews were conducted with 33 candidates.

In the competitions for vacant judicial positions at the Specialised Circuit Administrative Court and the Specialised Administrative Court of Appeal, the checking of candidates' compliance with the requirements for the position of judge, based on the submitted documents, has been completed. A total of 171 candidates have been admitted to participate in the competition for the Specialised Circuit Administrative Court, and 109 candidates have been admitted to participate in the competition for the Specialised Administrative Court of Appeal.

A qualification assessment and a qualification exam have been scheduled within the framework of the competitions for the Specialised Circuit Administrative Court and the Specialised Administrative Court of Appeal. The sequence of the stages of the qualification exam has been determined as follows: 1) testing of knowledge of the history of Ukrainian statehood; 2) testing of cognitive abilities; 3) testing of general knowledge in the field of law and knowledge in the specialisation of the respective court; 4) completion of a practical assignment in the specialisation of the respective court.
